Priority Policies

Civil Penalty for Low-Level Marijuana Possession

Current criminal marijuana penalties are harsh and unreasonable. More than 66,000 people were arrested in 2017 alone.

- Institute a civil penalty for small amounts of marijuana; no arrest, no jail time, and no criminal record for less than one ounce.

Safe and Legal Medicinal Access to Cannabis

Texas' Compassionate Use Program (T.CUP) allows only those with intractable epilepsy to use low-THC cannabis.

- Extend compassionate access to those with debilitating medical conditions by making T.CUP more inclusive for patients.
